DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMICS

On June 1st, 2022, the Department began its activities. Classes for Semester 4 and Semester 2 commenced on the very first day of the academic year. In the afternoon, there was staff meeting to discuss various academic programmes that are to be organised during the academic year 2022-2023.

As the faculty members were very actively involved in NAAC Accreditation SSR preparation, the formal inauguration of the Economics Association 'ECONOMICAS' was conducted little bit late. The formal inauguration of the activities of the Economics Association was done by Dr.Pradeep Kumar B, Associate Professor of Economics, Maharajas College on 28th November, 2022. He has presented a Seminar on "MSME-The Growth Engines of Indian Economy". A large number of students from various Departments attended the programme.

We had 56 percent result with one A Grade for the sixth semester. In the fourth semester, we achieved a pass percentage of 66.67%, which is higher than the pass percentage for the university. Even with limited number of students, the Department achieved runner-up during the annual athletic meet conducted by the college on 23-02-23.

The Department conducted staff meetings regularly and evaluated the performance of students. The faculty members have very effectively given mentoring and completed Mentees' Chronicle.

Under the banner of career guidance cell, Mr. Anishkumar A S organised a number of orientation career enrichment classes. He is currently pursuing a part-time Ph.D and is also a resource person for many institutions. DEPARTMENT OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION

DEPARTMENT OF LIBRARY

Mar Ivanios College of Arts and Science (MICAS) library is an academic library. The college library is a treasure house of information, inspiration, and recreation and is the heart of the institution. The college library is situated at the centre, near the entrance of the college at the ground floor. MICAS library started its functioning with the inception of the college since 2015.

Students and staff of the MICAS college constitutes the clientele of the library. The users have free access to the library facilities from 9AM to 5PM. The library has a total floor area of 1626*900 sq.ft. The library is equipped with sufficient chairs and tables for reading within a good ventilated room for the users. Different sections are allotted in the library for reference, career guidance, internet browsing, OPAC, journals, magazines and newspapers. The reading room is capable for 64 users. Every year library advisory committee is constituted to strengthen its activity. The library is equipped with seven computers with high-speed broadband connection. The library has a good collection of books, journals, periodicals, newspapers, CD's, e-resources, back volumes of journals and previous year question papers. Library collection includes over 6200 books, 6000 e-journals, 164300 e-books, 5 printed

journals, 201 open access journals, 23 periodicals and 7 newspapers. The college library is partially automated with ILMS software KOHA (version 20.05, Year 2016). Documents are classified according to the Dewey decimal classification and the catalogue search is done through the computerized OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue) interface of KOHA. The circulation of books is done using bar-coded ID cards. All books are bar-coded with their accession numbers. When the readers' ID card is scanned his/her profile is displayed on the screen and the book is issued by scanning the book's barcode. Though it is automated, Brownie charging system is also maintained for circulation. Readers are given 'Reader's ticket' at the time of taking membership and every book has its own card showing the bibliographic details.

The library is Wi-Fi connected. The activities of library related services are available in the institutional website. Open access journals, previous year question papers, e-newspapers, e-encyclopaedia, e-thesis and feedback mechanism are also available in the site. Institutional repositories and previous year question papers are stored in Dspace digital library software. The staff and students are allotted separate ID and passwords for the use of INFLIBNET facility. The registered user can access more than 6000 e-journals and 164300 e-books using N-list of INFLIBNET. The library conducts orientation classes to the users every year to make them aware of various services and e-resources available in the institution. Installation of CCTV is facilitated in and around the library. The best library user award is constituted to encourage reading habits in students. All matters related to the library are communicated to its users through e-mail and notice board.

Ms. Meera R, Ms. Beena Joseph & Ms. Jessy Kuruvila are in charge of the library services and activities. Acknowledging the efforts taken by the librarian and team.

EXTENSION AND CLUB ACTIVITIES

It is mandatory for a student to participate in any one of the following Social Service/Extension Activities for not less than forty hours, during the 3rd and 4th semesters, for successful completion of the Programme. General Co ordinator is Ms. Tintu Anna Mohan. The various extension activities offered are National Service Scheme, Literary Club and Environment Club.

1) NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME **(UNIT No: KL 07-120-A&B)**

The NSS has been introduced in colleges and universities all over India in response to the Kothari Commission's recommendation that education should be oriented to the social needs by involving students in service to the community. There are 2 units with hundred students and they are given training to engage themselves in constructive social action. Certificates are given to volunteers who complete 240 hours of social work during the course of two years. This certificate gives weightage for higher studies and is an additional qualification for appointment in public services.
